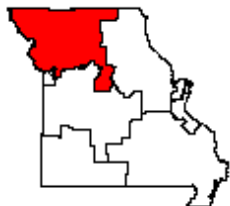




Impact on U.S. Congressional District 6

UM Services Received in Your District in 2008

- 2 patients seen at the UMSL Center for Eye Care with an average of \$125 per patient in uncompensated care.
- 3,161 patients seen at the UMKC School of Dentistry with an average of \$30 per patient in uncompensated care.
- 167,742 educational contacts with MU Extension through MU Extension events held in district counties.

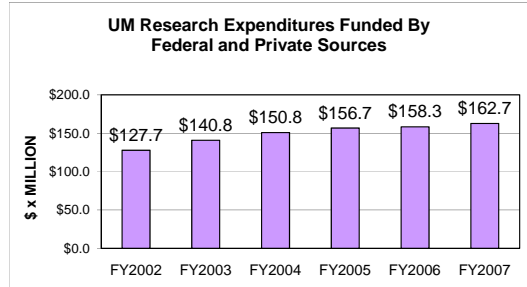

Economic Development Highlights

- With \$2.44 billion in total revenues, UM would have been the 20th largest publicly-held Missouri-headquartered company in the state in 2008.
- With more than 25,000 employees in the state, UM was Missouri's 2nd largest employer in 2007.
- 40% of Missouri's academic science and technology research expenditures were conducted at UM in 2006.
- UM earned 51% of total funding to public universities in Missouri by the National Science Foundation in 2006.
- Federal grant funding at UM increased 13.4% to \$193 million in 2005.
- UM was issued 20 U.S. patents in 2008.
- UM filed 52 new U.S. patent applications in 2008.
- 5 startups were created around UM technologies in 2008.
- UM earned \$6.7 million in licensing income in 2008.

Financial Aid Provided to UM Students in 2008

- \$651.4 million
 - \$317.1 million - MU
 - \$158.0 million - UMKC
 - \$66.4 million - Missouri S&T
 - \$109.9 million - UMSL

Electronic Services to the State in 2008

- The Missouri Research & Education Network (MOREnet) served 66 higher education institutions with 346,000 students and 48,000 faculty and staff.
- MOREnet served 514 school districts with 864,000 students and 88,000 faculty and staff.
- MOREnet served 316 library buildings serving 5.3 million Missourians.
- The Missouri Bibliographic Information User System (MOBIUS) loaned 290,000 books from higher education institutions to state students.

Impact on Education in 2008

- UM awarded 47% of the 1,027 doctoral degrees earned in Missouri.
- UM awarded 49% of the 1,577 first-professional degrees earned in Missouri.
- UM awarded 55% of the 25,350 degrees awarded by Missouri's four-year public institutions.
