Thomas Jefferson Award Criteria for Nomination and Selection

Description:

The Thomas Jefferson Award recognizes faculty who rise above excellence and demonstrate clear distinction in teaching, research, writing, creative activities, and service to the University of Missouri and humankind.

Number of awards and award amounts:

There will be up to one \$10,000 award, less applicable taxes. The award also includes the Thomas Jefferson Cup.

Who is eligible to be nominated?

Any faculty member, active or emeritus, associated with one of the campuses for at least ten years may be nominated. The award will be given annually.

Who may nominate?

Candidates may be nominated by any benefits-eligible faculty member or administrator.

Selection Committee

Representatives from each campus will be appointed by the provost.

Criteria

The Thomas Jefferson Award, funded through a grant from the Robert Earl McConnell Foundation, honors a member of the University of Missouri community who through personal influence and performance of duty in teaching, writing and scholarship, character and influence, devotion and loyalty to the University best exemplifies the principles and ideals of Thomas Jefferson. For example, Jefferson encouraged competition among ideas, rejected superstition in favor of a scientific and rational world view, believed that society and government should be tolerant of differences, supported free public education and the application of knowledge to the solution of public problems, and was devoted to free expression. In light of its stated purpose, the Thomas Jefferson Award recognizes individuals who rise above excellence and demonstrate clear distinction in teaching, research, writing, creative activities, and service to the University of Missouri and humankind.

The recipient of this award will hold the title of Thomas Jefferson Professor during the year that he/she is the current recipient. After one year, the title of "Thomas Jefferson Fellow" may be used.

The nomination packet shall include in the following order:

- 1. The completed cover sheet.
- 2. A letter of support from the nominator. Limit: two pages.
- 3. A statement from the nominee providing additional or clarifying information to strengthen the nomination. Limit: 500 words.
- 4. A CV of five pages or less emphasizing material relevant to the award.
- 5. Up to five additional letters of support which may include external referees. Limit: two pages each.
 - ✓ Do not scan transmittal letter or title pages between the above sections.
 - ✓ Materials utilizing font size smaller than 10 point will not be accepted.
 - ✓ Do not include the Criteria Sheet.
