The 2004-2005 Report of Degrees Awarded by the University of Missouri

Executive Summary

This report includes graphs and tables of the annual number of degrees awarded by the University of Missouri System from fiscal year 1995-96 (FY96) through fiscal year 2004-2005 (FY05). The long-term trend of degrees awarded is shown graphically by campus (Figure 1) and by degree level within each campus (Figure 2).

Table 1 of this report provides the number of awards by campus and level and by campus college (Tables 2.1-2.4) from FY 1996 to FY2005 as well as average change for 3, 5, and 10 year periods. In addition Tables 1, and Tables 2.1-2.4 provide percent changes in FY2005 relative to the 10 year average.

Degrees awarded are reported by department in the Appendix in the *Department Detail Summary* (Tables 3.1-3.4). The official annual reporting period is from July 1 to June 30 of the following calendar year. For example, FY05 includes summer and fall graduates from 2004 and the spring graduates of 2004.

The highlights of the report include:

- The University of Missouri System awarded a record 12,984 degrees in FY05, a 14% change in FY2005 relative to the 10-year average (Table 1).
- The University of Missouri System change in FY05 relative to the 10 year bachelors degrees is a 13% increase and for master's degrees a 17% increase.

Notes Regarding Use of the Report:

- Please note the axis scale range when considering graphs. It may change from campus to campus.
- Previous year's tables may differ because tables in the report have been changed from the use of running averages to 3, 5, and 10 year averages.
- This report includes a 10 year average as related to FY05.
- Source for this report is the printed Completions Report (Table 7).
- This report reflects the official counts of degrees awarded, as of July 1 for the preceding year that were submitted to the state and federal government.

Technical Notes for Use with the Report:

Footnotes

- Footnotes are of the utmost importance in reading tables in the appendix.

Name Changes

- If a program name changes, the report history is changed to reflect the new name and is footnoted.
- If a degree name or description is changed, the report history is changed to the new description and is footnoted.
- If a department name changes, the report history is changed to the new description and NO footnotes are made.
- If a school or college changes, the report history is changed to the new description and NO footnotes are made.

Program Moves

- If a program moves to another department or school, the data are reported as is – that is, report history is not changed and the new data are reported in the new department. A new footnote is added, i.e., program is moving. Eventually – when there are no more degrees for the old department, the old department is hidden in the report.
- If a program moves to another school or college, the data are reported as is – that is, report history is not changed and the new data are reported in the new school or college. A footnote is added, i.e., program is moving. Eventually – when there are no more degrees for the old department, the old department is hidden in the report.

Figure 1: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1996





Figure 1: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1996





Figure 1: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1996




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1996




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1996




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1996




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1996




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1996


