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The 2007-2008 Report of Degrees Awarded by the University of Missouri

Executive Summary

This report includes graphs and tables of degrees awarded by each campus since 1999. The first table provides a summary of degrees by level for each campus, while the second table series gives the number of awards by the colleges of each campus. The *Department Detail Summary* reflects the number of degrees awarded by academic department. These tables also show the average number of degrees over a 3, 5, & 10-year period and the percent change in FY 2008 that is relative to the 10-year average.

The highlights of the report include:

- The University of Missouri System awarded a record 14,111 degrees, a 14% growth in FY 2008 relative to the 10-year average. (Table 1)
- Relative to the 10-year average, the number of FY 2008 bachelors degrees for the University of Missouri System increased 16%, and graduate certificates increased 103%.
- Comparing FY 2008 degrees to the 10-year averages, the most notable increases are: bachelors degrees awarded are up 16% at UM-Columbia and 19% at Missouri S&T; masters degrees are up 24% at UM-Columbia; and doctorates are up 20% at UM-Columbia and 37% at UM-St. Louis.
- First Professional degrees at UM-Kansas City increased 7% when comparing FY 2008 to the 10-year average.

Notes Regarding Use of the Report:

- The official annual reporting period is from July 1 to June 30 of the following calendar year. For example, FY08 includes summer and fall graduates from 2007 and the spring graduates of 2008.
- Please note the axis scale range when considering graphs. It may change from campus to campus.
- Previous year's tables may differ because tables in the report have been changed from the use of running averages to 3, 5, and 10 year averages.
- This report includes a 10-year average as related to FY 2008.
- Source for this report is the printed Completions Report.

Technical Notes for Use with the Report:

Footnotes

- Footnotes are of the utmost importance in reading tables in the appendix.

Name Changes

- If a program name changes, the report history is changed to reflect the new name and is footnoted.
- If a degree name or description is changed, the report history is changed to the new description and is footnoted.
- If a department name changes, the report history is changed to the new description and NO footnotes are made.
- If a school or college changes, the report history is changed to the new description and NO footnotes are made.

Program Moves

- If a program moves to another department or school, the data are reported as is – that is, report history is not changed and the new data are reported in the new department. A new footnote is added, i.e., program is moving. Eventually – when there are no more degrees for the old department, the old department is hidden in the report.
- If a program moves to another school or college, the data are reported as is – that is, report history is not changed and the new data are reported in the new school or college. A footnote is added, i.e., program is moving. Eventually – when there are no more degrees for the old department, the old department is hidden in the report.

Figure 1: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1999





Figure 1: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1999




Figure 1: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1999




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1999




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1999




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1999




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1999




Figure 2: Rate of Change in Total Degrees Awarded by Campus, since 1999


