The 2000-2001 Report of Degrees Awarded by the University of Missouri

Rational for Revised Report

The original Degrees Awarded Report, 2001 was published in September 2001. Please note that the **number of degrees awarded** by campus level, college, and department are correct. However, in some cases the **percentage changes over five and ten years were not correct**. Consequently, the changes have been made to the appropriate tables.

Executive Summary

This report discusses the annual number of degrees awarded by the University of Missouri System from fiscal year 1980-81 (FY81) through fiscal year 2000-2001 (FY01). The figures and tables of this report display the distribution of awards by campus and level (Table 1), by campus college (Tables 2.1-2.4), and by campus college department (Tables 3.1-3.4). In addition, the long-term trend of degrees awarded is shown graphically by campus (Figure 1) and by degree level within campus (Figure 2). Degrees awarded are reported by department in the accompanying document *Department Detail Summary*. In all cases, academic degree programs that have moved from one unit to another and units that have moved from one school to another have been reported as if they had always been where they are now. The official annual reporting period is from July 1 to June 30 of the following calendar year. For example, FY01 includes summer and fall graduates from 2000 and the spring graduates of 2001. The data tables of the report show percentage annual change from FY00 to FY01 and FY01 relative to the prior 5-year and 10-year averages. Collectively, these statistics help to communicate whether recent change in production is short or long-term. Please note the axis scale range when considering graphs.

The highlights of the report include:

- The University of Missouri System awarded 11,182 degrees in FY01, a 2% increase in the number of degrees awarded in FY00. There has been an average 5% increase in the total number of degrees awarded since 1996.
- Of the 5% average increase in degrees awarded since 1996, most of the change has been due to a significant increase in the number of bachelors degrees awarded.
- The number of doctoral degrees awarded by the University of Missouri System increased by an average of 12% over the past ten years.

UM-Columbia

UM-Columbia awarded a total of 5,349 degrees in FY01. Compared to the previous fiscal year, there was a 3% decrease in the number of bachelors degrees awarded; 200% increase in educational specialist degrees; 11% increase in masters degrees; and a 9% increase in doctoral degrees (Table 1).

The College of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources produced 435 degrees in FY01. The number of masters degrees awarded increased by nearly 35% from the previous fiscal year, while the number of bachelors degrees declined by 3% and the number of doctoral degrees decreased by 8%.

The largest college, Arts and Sciences, showed fairly consistent growth in degree production from the late 1970s through FY94 and rapid decline since FY94. Recovery began in FY98, continued into FY99, and reached a 20-year high in FY00. However, in FY01 the total number of degrees awarded decreased 5% from the previous year and this decline is due to a 7% drop in the number of bachelor degrees awarded.

Since FY92, the number of degrees awarded by the College of Business declined sharply to a local low point in FY97. Masters degrees bounced back in FY98 and the number of bachelors degrees awarded in FY01 (497) were the most granted since FY94.

The College of Education awarded a total of 607 degrees in FY01. On average, there has been a 7% decrease in the total degrees awarded over the past 5 years and 14% decrease over the past 10 years.

After significant growth in the number of engineering degrees awarded in FY00, there was a 13% decline in degrees completed in FY01 (453). The number of bachelors degrees decreased by 12% and the number of doctoral degrees decreased by 56%.

There was a 109% increase in the total number of degrees awarded in the School of Health Related Professions and much of this change is due to the new Masters in Physical Therapy program.

For the second year in a row, the College of Human Environmental Sciences reached another 20-year high with a total of 311 degrees awarded. While the number of masters degrees awarded have declined significantly since FY 1993, total bachelors and doctoral degrees have increased significantly over the past ten years.

In FY97 the number of degrees awarded in the School of Journalism had declined by about 30% when compared to 10 years before. FY98 showed a sharp reversal in the trend and there was a 1% increase in the number of degrees awarded in FY01 compared to the previous fiscal year.

The School of Law produced a record number of JDs in FY99. The FY99 figure was about 41% higher than the fairly stable level of the preceding 5 years and was the result of a large increase in the number of students enrolled in law. That figure dropped in FY00 by 10% and the number of JD degrees awarded further decreased by 5% in FY01.

The School of Medicine awarded 150 degrees in FY01. There was a 10% increase in the number of MDs and 122% increase in doctoral degrees awarded.

The School of Natural Resources sharply increased the number of degrees awarded in FY99 but returned to more typical, 5- to 10-year, levels in FY00. This trend continued with a 25% decrease in the number of degrees awarded in FY01.

The School of Nursing produced a total of 180 degrees in FY01. While there was a 26% increase in masters degrees, the percentage of bachelors degrees declined by 6%.

The School of Social Work produced a 20-year record 128 degrees in FY01. From FY00, the number of bachelors degrees awarded increased by 36% and the number of masters degrees awarded increased by 51%.

UM-Kansas City

Total degrees awarded at UM-Kansas City (2,284) increased by 4% during FY01 (Table 1).

After a record number in bachelors degrees awarded in the College of Arts and Sciences, there was a 2% decrease in bachelors degrees completed in FY01. The number of masters degrees increased by 7%. Since 1991, the number of degrees awarded in the College of Arts and Sciences has increased on average nearly 20%.

Bachelors degrees awarded in biological sciences decreased by 9% in FY01. This is a continuation of the sharp decline in FY00. The number of masters degrees increased by 44% in FY01.

Total degrees awarded in business and public administration increased by 16% in FY01. Bachelors degrees awarded increased by 6% and masters degrees awarded increased by 22%.

The total number of dentistry degrees and certificates awarded during FY01 decreased by 10%.

The College of Education produced 346 degrees in FY01. This 13% increase in degrees awarded since the previous year follows 4 years of steady decline. While the number of masters degrees declined nearly 3%, the number of bachelors, educational specialists, and doctoral degrees increased significantly by 36%, 44%, and 100%, respectively.

Law produced 146 JDs in FY01. This was an 11% increase from FY00.

The number of degrees awarded in medicine dropped by 12% from the previous year.

A record 112 degrees were produced by the Conservatory of Music. This was an increase of 44% from the previous year and is consistent with the significant increase in 5 and 10- year averages of 34% and 38%, respectively.

For the second year in a row, the total number of nursing degrees completed declined. The number of masters degrees awarded decreased by 17% in FY01. The number of bachelors degrees awarded increased by 5%.

Pharmacy has completed its transitional phase from bachelors to doctor of pharmacy degrees and had a 4% increase in the number of DPHM degrees in FY01.

UM-Rolla

Degree production in the School of Engineering increased by 5% in FY01. This increase can be attributed to a 24% increase in the number of masters degrees awarded during FY01. However, the number of bachelors degrees awarded continued to decline, decreasing by 6% in FY01 (Table 2.3).

The number of degrees awarded in Arts and Sciences was down by 5% in FY01 due to a sharp decrease in both master and doctoral degrees awarded. The number of bachelors degrees awarded during FY01 increased by 5%.

Although the number of masters degrees awarded in the School of Mines and Metallurgy increased by 23% in FY01, the total number of degrees awarded declined by 18%. This decline was due to a 26% decrease in the bachelors degrees completed during FY01.

UM-St. Louis

UM-St. Louis has consistently shown long-term growth in the number of degrees awarded (Figure 1). A total of 2,456 degrees were awarded in FY01, a 6% increase in the number of degrees awarded in the previous fiscal year (Table 1).

Degree completions in the College of Arts and Sciences have increased significantly over the past 20 years. The 921 degrees awarded in FY01 represent a 85% increase in the number of degrees completed since 1981. However, while steadily increasing, the rate of degree production is slowing down. There was an average 22% increase over the last 10 years, 13% increase over the past 5 years, and a 7% increase from FY00 to FY01 (Table 2.4).


The School of Business Administration reversed a downward trend in FY99 that began in about FY91 and has continued to grow in FY01. The number of degrees awarded increased by 8% in FY01.

The number of degrees awarded by the School of Education increased by 8% in FY01. This is a reversal of the significant drop in degrees awarded during FY00.

Both the number of bachelors and masters degrees in Nursing were down sharply in FY01. The number of bachelors degrees awarded decreased by 21% from the previous fiscal year. The number of masters degrees decreased by 55% during the same time period.

The School of Optometry awarded 45 degrees in FY01, a number relatively unchanged in the last 3 years.

Figure 1: Total Degrees Awarded by Campus







Figure 1: Total Degrees Awarded by Campus - Continued






Figure 1: Total Degrees Awarded by Campus - Continued







Figure 2: Total Degrees Awarded by Campus







Figure 2: Total Degrees Awarded by Campus






Figure 2: Total Degrees Awarded by Campus






Figure 2: Total Degrees Awarded by Campus







Figure 2: Total Degrees Awarded by Campus


