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FALL 2000 ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

Rationale for Revised Report

The original Fall 2000 Enrollment Summary Report was published in October 2000. However, registration for dually enrolled high school students at the University of Missouri- St. Louis was not complete by the official census date. Subsequently, total enrollment figures for both the St. Louis campus and the System reported in October were less than the actual number of students enrolled. Since the census date, UMSL has revised its census enrollment data and this revised report reflects those changes. Compared to the original report, only the tables and bullets for the St. Louis campus and the System are affected by this revision.

This report summarizes the status and trends in fall enrollment at the University of Missouri's four campuses. Enrollments are presented in a series of six tables. Table 1a summarizes the first-time on-campus headcount by student level for each campus since 1996. Table 1b summarizes the fall total headcount enrollments for each campus and the System for the same time period. Table 2 displays fall 2000 enrollments by campus, student level, and characteristics such as residency, full- and part-time status, and student full-time equivalency. Following Tables 1a-b and Table 2 are a series of tables displaying more detailed enrollment and student characteristics for the System and each individual campus. Tables 3.0-3.4 depict on-campus and off-campus headcount and full-time equivalency enrollments as well as student credit hours by student level. On-campus and off-campus enrollments by residency, full- and part-time status, and student level are shown in Tables 4.0-4.4. Table 5.0 shows enrollments by student level, gender, and ethnic characteristics, and Table 6.0 displays UMKC headcount enrollment in its six-year dentistry and medicine programs.

Technical Notes

These tables provide counts of students enrolled in the fall 2000 on-schedule credit courses of the four campuses of the University of Missouri. Fall 1999 counts are included in the Table 3 series (3.0-3.4) for comparison purposes. The data included in these tables were prepared in the admissions and registration offices at the respective campuses. The data are counts as of the census data at each campus, which is defined as the end of the fourth week of classes for the fall session. The reports were generally based on the reporting guidelines and definitions of the Coordinating Board for Higher Education (CBHE) and the National Center for Educational Statistics (NCES).

Each of the tables in the Table 3 and Table 4 series include counts of on- and off-campus students. The columns titled "On-Campus", according to the CBHE guidelines, include students enrolled geographically on campus and students in the Graduate Engineering (Residence) Centers. All other students are counted in the columns headed "Off-Campus". The tables of the Table 3 series also include full-time equivalence (FTE) counts. FTE is defined as 15 semester credit hours for undergraduates and 12 semester credit hours for graduates. For professional programs, FTE is defined as 15 semester hours for Law, 18 for UM Columbia Medicine, and 16 for Veterinary Medicine. For Dentistry, UMKC Medicine, Optometry, and Pharmacy, FTE is equal to headcount.

Caveats

First- and second-year students in the Dentistry DDS and Medicine MD programs at UMKC are included in the undergraduate counts of the Table 3 and Table 4 series. For this reason, headcount enrollments for students at all years in these two programs are summarized in Table 6.

Enrollment counts for students in "Off-Schedule" courses, which include intersession courses, short courses, Video Credit courses, and other courses which begin and end on dates other than those for the regular academic semester, are accumulated during the term in which the courses began and are reported the semester following their end date.

Dually-Enrolled High School Students

In 1999 the CBHE set a reporting policy that all dually-enrolled high school students shall be counted in the total undergraduate headcount. Further specifications of this new policy are that only high school juniors and seniors with a B average are eligible for dual-enrollment and that all teachers in dual credit programs must have a masters degree in order to teach these courses. This CBHE policy significantly changed the UMKC and UMSL enrollments in different ways. Because dually-enrolled high school students were not previously counted in the undergraduate headcount at the Kansas City campus, the inclusion of these students caused an increase of 1,322, or 132%, in the off-campus nondegree-seeking headcount for fall 2000.

On the other hand, the St. Louis campus, which in previous years has counted dually-enrolled high school students in the undergraduate headcount, experienced a slight decrease in the off-campus nondegree-seeking headcount. Because of new CBHE specifications, both high school students and teachers eligible for the dual-enrollment program have decreased on the St. Louis campus.

Tables 1a, 1b and 2: Fall Enrollment History and Summary of Fall 2000 Enrollments

- The University of Missouri had a total enrollment of 56,030 in fall of 2000. This is a 3% increase in enrollment over the past five years.
- UM-Columbia enrolled 42% (23,309 students) of total students at the University of Missouri, UM-St. Louis 27% (15,397 students), UM-Kansas City 23% (12,698 students), and UM-Rolla 8% (4,626 students).
- The University of Missouri enrolled 42,584 undergraduate students (76% of total headcount), 2,665 first professional students (5%), and 10,781 graduate students (19%).
- Eighty-three percent of all students enrolled at the University are Missouri residents.
- Of the 56,030 students enrolled System-wide, 65% are full-time students.

- Total headcount enrollment at the University increased 2% from 54,703 in fall 1999 to 56,030 in fall 2000.
- Undergraduate enrollment increased by 3% and graduate enrollment increased by 2% from 1999. First professional enrollment decreased by 1%.
- The number of first-time degree seeking freshmen enrolling at the University of Missouri increased by 270 students over fall 1999, an increase of 5%.
- First-time degree seeking graduate students totaled 2,218, an increase of 1% from fall 1999.
- The total FTE enrollments and SCH produced increased by 2%.

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Columbia increased 2% (379 students) from 22,930 in fall 1999 to 23,309 in fall 2000.
- UM-Columbia experienced a record first-time freshman enrollment of 4,226, up 294 (7%) from fall 1999.
- First-time first professional and graduate degree seeking enrollment increased 6% and 4%, respectively.
- When all levels were combined, FTE enrollment and SCH produced each increased 3% over fall 1999.

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Kansas City was 12,698 in fall 2000, an 11% increase over the total of 11,464 in fall 1999. FTE enrollment rose by 5% during the last year. However, the increase was primarily the result of the 1999 CBHE decision that all dually-enrolled high school students shall be counted in the total undergraduate headcount. The Kansas City campus has been working to more accurately reflect dual-credit enrollments and their effort is evidenced by this change.
- Undergraduate enrollment increased by 1% for on-campus students while on-campus first professional and graduate enrollment decreased by 2% and 3%, respectively.
- Enrollment of first-time degree seeking freshmen increased by 20 students or 3% over fall 1999.

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Rolla decreased from 4,715 students in fall 1999 to 4,626 students in fall 2000, a decline of 2% on top of the 4% decline in 1999.
- The number of first-time degree seeking freshmen decreased 1% from fall 1999 to fall of 2000.
- The number of first-time graduate degree seeking students was 226, an increase of 24% from fall 1999.
- While the on-campus FTE enrollment and SCH produced increased by 8 % at the graduate level, the undergraduate level declined by 4%.

- At the undergraduate level, 72% of degree seeking freshmen and sophomores are enrolled full-time, compared to 51% of degree seeking juniors and seniors. Only 18% of graduate students are enrolled full-time.
- Ninety-five percent of undergraduates at UM-St. Louis are Missouri residents, while 85% of graduate students are residents. Of the 169 first professional students, 49% are residents of Missouri.

- Total enrollment at the University of Missouri is 54% women and 46% men. UM-St. Louis has the largest percentage of women (62%) and UM-Rolla has the highest proportion of men (77%).
- The first professional level has an equal proportion of men and women (50%) while students at the undergraduate and graduate levels are more likely to be women (53% and 56% respectively).
- Under-represented minorities (American Indian/Alaskan Native, African-American, and Hispanic) represent 11% of the University of Missouri's total enrollment. UM-Kansas City enrolls the largest proportion (14.3%) followed by UM-St. Louis (13.7%), UM-Columbia (8%), and UM-Rolla (5.6%).
- UM-St. Louis has an African-American enrollment of 1,760 students, 12% of its total, and the largest percentage among the four campuses.
- UM-Kansas City enrolls higher percentages of Asian/Pacific Islanders and Hispanics, 5.6% and 3.3% respectively, than the other four campuses.
- Although nonresident aliens comprise only 6% of total enrollment at the University of Missouri, they represent 20.7% of the total graduate enrollment. UM-Rolla enrolls the largest percentage of nonresident alien graduate students (52.2%).
