Units across campus have developed budget realignment scenarios, leaders have held campuswide budget forums, and information has been broadly and frequently shared related to budget processes and proposed realignment scenarios. Our guiding principles will be to:

- Challenge the status quo and long-held traditions that are impediments to change
