The reason for contacting you is to inquire about the drawings for the trays. (A Tray, B Tray, C Tray, D Tray & E Tray). In the bid under <b>Section 1.0 General</b> , you mention attached drawings, but I do not see any attachments.	The bid language was incorrect. We cannot provide drawings of the trays.
Page 7 Section 2.1 2.11 Materials Your specification shows 200B natural kraft corrugated paperboard. To provide the acid free lignin free specifications the board MUST BE 200B triple bleached corrugated	The important spec is that the board be acid-free, so if 200B triple bleached corrugated is needed for acid-free, then that is what we need.
Since we currently have all required cutting dies they are our property and not the property of University of Missouri page 8 Section 2.12 Tooling	The sizes are more or less standardized across Harvard-style depositories, so that is fine as long as their existing cutting dies are the right dimensions.
Are items bundled 25 per bundle, unitized, and palletized. Normal die cut production is just unotized and palletized	They don't necessarily need to be bundled if there is a price advantage, however bundled, unitized and palletized is what we currently get from Riverdale.

<p>What is time frame for delivery after award of contract and will delivery be all at once. I assume this is one time order and shipment.</p>	<p>Time frame is delivery by April 1, 2021 for the full order (noted below). If vendor cannot meet that deadline, please provide an expected delivery date as close to April 1 as possible. This is the first order, representing roughly 25% of total trays needed. The vendor can expect several more orders of similar volume within the next 3-5 years.</p> <p>Item A - 2,500 trays/order  Item B - 4,000 trays/order  Item C - 2,250 trays/order  Item D - 3,000 trays/order  Item E - 500 trays/order</p>

<p>Quote would be predicated upon paper costs of March 1, 2021</p>	<p>It is understood that prices may vary for future orders based on paper costs.</p>
