First set of Questions Received (UM Answers are in RED):

Please see a few questions below in regard to the bid request listed in the subject line:

- General Description: #6. The University of Missouri will install all digital alarm communication equipment, in any additional campus buildings under a separate contract. The monitoring will start as each building is completed.
 Will UMSL provide the model number for the digital alarm communication equipment it currently has installed at each building and the equipment it plans to install in future buildings? We ask the question as different communicators utilize different cellular services with different fees. The UMSL standard is Telguard TG-7FS commercial fire alarm communicator
- 2. Will UMSL allow for us to coordinate a site survey of the current equipment and set up sometime the week of the 5th? Yes, we would do one tour time for all bidders. (See Page 3)
- 3. Will UMSL provide a signal history report for each site from the past 30 days? Yes, a pdf copy of the report will be attached to the UM email reply. See page 3 of this addendum for the date and time.
- 4. Test Signals: #1. All connected buildings will be tested on an annual basis by University staff. Vendor shall work with University staff during testing and shall record the receipt of test signals and provide a summary report to the University. Will UMSL coordinate annual inspections with their own staff after the successful bidder has migrated the accounts to their own central station? Yes
- 5. Will UMSL be expecting the successful bidder to also provide time and material service on the fire alarm systems installed or only to provide for central monitoring services? This will only include central monitoring services.



6. Are any of the systems on UMSLs campus UL certificated; either UUFX or UUJS? If so, will the successful bidder be required to provide all associated services and fees required to maintain a UUFX or UUJS certification? (See attached ordinance) If UMSL does have UUFX or UUJS certificated buildings we would have additional follow up questions. UMSL does not have any UUFX or UUJS certificated buildings.

No, this should be included as a one-time fee. If applicable, please add a line to Pricing page 12 of your bid submission for your one-time fee!!!
- 3. Can you clarify that the retransmission of an alarm signal can occur AFTER the fire department is dispatched? The scope says it must be retransmitted immediately, but our protocol is to contact the fire department first. If this is not the case, we will require a waiver from the fire marshal. This scope reads:

Upon receiving an alarm signal, operators shall immediately re-transmit to:

A. UMSL Campus Police Department and UMSL Facilities and Maintenance Department. The answer is yes. I spoke with our Chief of Police on campus and the first call should go to the Fire department and the secondary call to UMSL PD.

Third and final set of Questions Received (UM Answers are in RED):

....just want to clarify on the number of buildings outlined below (see the list on page 11 of the bid), am I to count 11 buildings or do the A,B,C,D sub category buildings need to be counted as well? See Question number 1 above in the Second set of questions.
