QUESTION	ANSWER
During the duct cleaning will there be any issues silencing the smoke alarm systems within the duct work?	We will be able to silence the alarms during times while work is being performed.
Will there be any issues propping doors open during the project and running vacuum hoses (8-12" and 1" air line through them?	Can coordinate with campus security to schedule this.
Will filters be provided?	Filter material for the diffuser outlets shall be procured and installed by contractor. AHU air filters will be provided by owner.
Some of the supply grills have covers on them once the system is cleaned we will need to remove those, are there any reasons they would need to stay in place?	The covers on some of the existing supply grills will need to be removed and replaced. New covers on all supply grills will need to be in place throughout the duct cleaning activities to

	minimize any potential for release of any particulate when the systems are put back in operation. Once the cleaning has been complete and approved, the supply grill covers can then be removed.
Please verify the limit of a project before PW is required, and include PW info.	Due to the type of project, PW will not be necessary.
Can the university confirm that the only time we are able to work is evenings/nights.	Work will need to be overnight. Contractor is responsible for cleaning up prior to the next business day starting.
