- Q I am preparing a bid for the lease on the Thompson Research Farm. Could you tell me how many acres and which crop(s) were planted in 2022? Was all of the leased crop land planted and harvested?
- A Yes, all lease acres were planted. 2022 was planted to soybeans and are currently still in the field as of Tuesday. Combines were rolling in the area so I would expect they will be out soon.
- Q Can we get a copy of the 2015 grid sampling? Do you have one any more recent? Do you have the yield history for the farm that you can provide?
- A-I've attached a copy of the 2015 Grid Sampling. This is the latest we have on file. As far as a more recent one, the Director advised me on 10/28:
