Direct Student Funding

Ryan Highfill, ISC Chair/ASUM Executive Director

- Changes to ASUM Central & Chapter Funding
 - Funding method must change moving forward upon receiving guidance from UM System General Council for both ASUM Chapters and Central.
 - S&T-StuCo, Direct Student Funding (DSF) Organizations
 - From understanding meetings in General Council, it was under the interpretation that this will be applicable to all organizations that receive this preferential funding.
- S&T Student Council / Direct Student Funding Model
 - Nothing has been heard from General Council since forwarding them S&T's process and documents. Regardless of whether they decide that S&T's process is compliant, these organizations on all campuses will be affected by this.
 - Those present were in agreeance with bringing in General Council to present and speak at a future Intercampus Student Council.
- ASUM/ISC Merger Proposition
 - Merging ASUM Central mission, in a relevant manner, with the Intercampus Student Council to ensure continuity with ASUM's central mission and lobbying.
 - ASUM Chapter Presidents should have reached out to SGA President's already regarding the funding situation and with Chapters being absorbed by SGAs (or other similar solutions).

Student Representative to the Board of Curators

Grace Desjardins, ISC Vice Chair/UMSL-SGA Vice President

- Historical Context
 - Waiting on the MO Governor to appoint a student recommended by ISC, while previously remaining vacant out of respect for Remington, it has remained empty.
 - While the Student Curator is a non-voting member, it allows for a student to sit in during UM Board of Curators closed sessions.
 - We've progressed through UMSL's full term and halfway through Mizzou's, we're almost on S&T's. However, the CRR/RsMO only specifies the order of the sequence, referring to RsMO 172.035 and UM CRR 220.060.

- UMSL-SGA/Grace will file for information requests to confirm where the timeline left off the last time UMSL/ISC attempted to fill the position.
- Ideally, the goal will be to select and fill the Student Curator position. However, we'll look at other options to avoid the recurrence of the current circumstances, or when the Governor fails to make an appointment upon receiving nominations.
- Lucas/Grace will draft up Resolution to further discussions on confirming the University of selection for the Student Curator search. Then, they will send off to ISC Officers, and in the meantime, they're open to co-authors as well if anyone is interested in assisting.
 - We will use the ISC Resolution to provide greenlight to the corresponding SGA to begin the search process for candidates and to the MO Governor to confirm ISC's decision/reasoning.

Availability of Course Information

- Overview/Context
 - Continuing the conversation from previous years and wanted to gauge interest from the current council membership to see if a relevant topic for this year be.
 - Fundamentally, it's been noticed that access to the list of currently and previously offered courses via one-click directories varies heavily between the campuses, and between undergraduate and graduate students at each campus.
 - It would be an additional avenue for providing more accessible resources for students across the system, especially for online/distance-learning students.
- Course Catalogues & MyZou/MyView/Pathway/Joe'SS
- Stellic Adoption
 - Mizzou/S&T have begun migrating students from MyZou/Joe'SS to Stellic with full adoption ideally completed by the next academic year (Fall 2026). These efforts have been pushed often by Academic Advisors & University AA Dept.
 - UMSL not sure on progress/effort to migrate onto Stellic but will ask in meetings later with upper administration to clarify.
