The Student Health Fee provides funding for the MU Student Health Center, which offers primary care and behavioral health appointments. The Recreation Center Fee grants students access to university indoor and outdoor facilities at the Mizzou Rec Facility. The Student Activity Fee covers expenses for Student Government, Student Organizations, Multicultural Student Organizations, Readership Program, Sustainability Program, Sports Clubs, Associated Students, Capital Improvement, Divisional Councils, Transportation System, Student Unions, Student Life, Counseling Center, Jesse Auditorium, MU Libraries, and Technology.
