Enrollment Projections Report, 2002 Office of Institutional Research and Planning University of Missouri System

Executive Summary

The *Enrollment Projections Report*, 2002 includes University of Missouri enrollment projections for each of the four campuses and the System. Organized according to student level, it provides headcount and credit hour projections for the next five years. Each campus made headcount and credit hour projections and these projections are presented in this report unaltered. The totals for the UM System were calculated by adding totals from each of the four UM campuses. A special thanks to the following representatives who provided the enrollment projections for their campus: Rob. Taylor at UM-Columbia, Jennifer Spielvogel at UM-Kansas City, Carol Heddinghaus at UM-Rolla, and Linda Silman at UM-St. Louis.

The highlights of the report include:

- Full-time, first-time freshmen enrollment at the University of Missouri is projected to increase 5% over the next five years. This is a more conservative prediction from last year when enrollment was expected to increase by 10%. Freshmen enrollment is expected to remain relatively unchanged at the Columbia campus. The Kansas City and St. Louis campuses are predicting increases of 10% and 12%, respectively. Rolla anticipates the largest increase, a projected growth of 26%.
- System-wide, undergraduate headcount is expected to increase from 37,850 in fall of 2001 to 41,623 in the fall of 2006, an increase of 10%.
- Over the next five years, graduate headcount is expected to increase overall by 18%. Graduate enrollment is expected to increase on all campuses. The Columbia campus expects a 4% increase. The Kansas City campus anticipates a 15% increase. The St. Louis campus expects a 31% increase. The biggest increase in graduate enrollment is expected at Rolla with a predicted increase of 54%.
- Undergraduate on-campus, on-schedule credit hours across the System should see a 10% increase from approximately 472,839 credit hours in fall of 2001 to nearly 518,755 credit hours in the fall of 2006.
- Over the next five years, the Columbia, Kansas City, and Rolla campuses each expect a 1% decrease in undergraduate students that are Missouri residents. The percentage of graduate students that are Missouri residents are expected to remain the same for the Kansas City, Rolla, and St. Louis campuses. The Columbia campus expects a 4% decrease in the percentage of graduate students that are Missouri residents.

Organization of Report

The 2002 Enrollment Projections Report includes University of Missouri enrollment projections for each of the four campuses and the System. Organized according to student level, it provides headcount and credit hour projections for the next five years. Each campus made headcount and credit hour projections and these projections are presented in this report unaltered. The totals for the UM System were calculated by adding totals from each of the four UM campuses.

The text of this report refers to Tables 1-3 located in the body of the report. Please note, however, that more detailed information about the campus projections can be found in the appendix. Organized by campus, the tables in the appendix illustrate expected enrollment changes at the lower- and upper-division undergraduate levels, projections for each professional program (e.g., law, pharmacy, optometry, etc.), and enrollment forecasts at the graduate level. The appendix also includes more detailed information concerning the percentage of non-Missouri residents by level and the percentage of full-time students by level.

Considerations in Making Enrollment Projections

Making enrollment projections requires the careful consideration of several factors and influences that can affect future enrollments. For instance, depending on the campus, each of the following could influence enrollment: the effectiveness of an institution's recruiting and marketing strategy, shifts in the number of seniors graduating from high school, the economy, retention rates of students enrolled, and current tuition levels and anticipated increases. In addition, the competitiveness of other institutions vying for the same students, the availability of transfer students, changes in admission standards, new state policies or programs, and high school student interest in specific fields can all play a role.

Several factors influence on-campus enrollment projections at the University of Missouri. Foremost, the various enrollment management approaches on each of the four campuses continue to influence the five-year projections. For example, the St. Louis and Kansas City campuses are continuing to improve recruiting efforts at the local community colleges in order to attract more transfer students. At Columbia, the campus strategic plan's focus on graduate education continues to impact the expected increase in enrollments at the Masters and Doctoral levels over the next five years. The undergraduate enrollment projections at the Columbia campus are based on the sum of its first-time college projections, transfer projections, and continuing/readmit projections. Significant growth in enrollment is expected at the Rolla campus, which has activity plans and degree programs in place to achieve the projected growth.

On-Campus Enrollment Projections

UM-Columbia

Total on-campus headcount is expected to increase 4% from 23,563 in 2001 to 24,407 in 2006 (Table 1). This is a more conservative prediction from last year when enrollment was expected to increase by 9%. Total undergraduate enrollment is expected to increase by 4%, with no expected change in the number of first-time degree-seeking freshmen. Graduate enrollment is expected to increase by 4%, while first-professional enrollment is expected to remain the same (Table 2). The percentage of undergraduate Missouri residents and full-time students enrolled at UM-Columbia are expected to decrease by 1%. Over the next five years 86% of all undergraduate students will be Missouri residents and 94% will be enrolled full-time (Table 3).

UM-Kansas City

The Kansas City campus is predicting a much larger enrollment increase than previously expected. Over the next five years enrollment is expected to increase by 19% to approximately 12,900 students, with the largest increase expected at the undergraduate level (26%). First-time, degree-seeking freshmen enrollment is projected to increase by 10% (Table 2). Graduate enrollment is expected to increase by 15% and first-professional enrollment is expected to increase by 1% (Table 1). Full-time enrollment at the undergraduate level is projected to reach 76% over the next five years (Table 3).

UM-Rolla

Of the four campuses, the largest enrollment increase is expected at UM-Rolla. Anticipating a 31% increase in enrollment over the next five years, much of the growth is expected at the undergraduate level. By 2006, undergraduate enrollment is expected to reach 4,690. Graduate enrollment is projected to reach 1,412, an increase of 54% (Table 1). The percentage of full-time undergraduate and graduate students should remain steady at 90% and 81%, respectively (Table 3).

UM-St. Louis

Overall on-campus enrollment is projected to increase 11% over the next five years at UM-St. Louis. Undergraduate enrollment is expected to increase by 6% and professional enrollment by 4%. The largest growth is expected at the graduate level with an anticipated increase of 31% (Table 1). The percentage of students that are Missouri residents are expected to remain the same at all levels. The percentage of full-time undergraduates is expected to decrease by 56% while the first-professional and graduate levels remain the same at 100% and 21% (Table 3).

UM System Total

Overall, on-campus enrollment for the UM-System is expected to increase by 11% (Table 1). First-time freshmen enrollment is projected to increase by 5% (Table 2). Total undergraduate enrollment should increase by 10%, first-professional enrollment by 1%, and graduate enrollment by 18% (Table 1).
