## Emergency Kit

**Make sure your emergency kit is ready to go!**

- ✓ First Aid Kit
- ✓ Whistle (to call for help)
- ✓ Flashlight & extra batteries
- ✓ Cash & credit card
- ✓ Battery powered radio & weather radio
- ✓ Cellphone charger (solar/battery powered)
- ✓ 3-day supply of water/non-perishable food (for each family member including pets)
- ✓ Change of clothes/shoes for each family member
- ✓ Prescription medicine & special needs items
