Their local law is that even if one is driving and using a cell phone for GPS it cannot be held on the person. Internationals have been known to either pay and comply for not wanting to bother or advocate or in other cases bring up misconduct with private investigation in the police department or receive a response from the mayoral office (as was in my case) to hold men and women in uniform accountable for misconduct.
